

MGIT Report on the important events held / achievements during the month of **February, 2014**

1. The Department of Information Technology (IT) of MGIT, has organized an Inaugural Launch of **CSI-MGIT Chapter** and 1-Day Workshop on “**Exploring Internet**” for staff, UG & PG students on 18.02.2014 at MGIT. This workshop covered the topics such as Search Engine Optimization, InternetResources, how to earn money online, Web2.0, Practical Orientation on Hacking Techniques for Android Mobile Phones etc. Dr. A. Govardhan, Chairman CSI, Hyderabad Chapter, is the Chief Guest. Mr. K. Sai Satish, CEO of Indian Servers and Dr. G. Chandra Mohan Reddy, Principal, MGIT spoke on the occasion.
